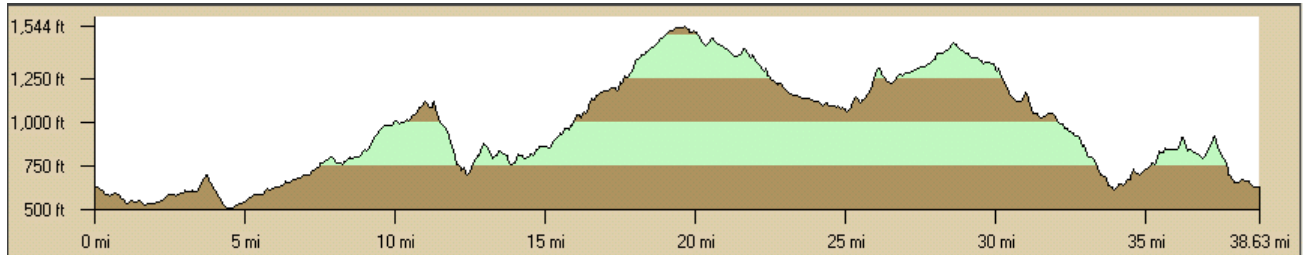


Traffic Notes:
 Green Valley Rd can have moderate to heavy traffic. Greenstone Road and Latrobe Road have moderate traffic and can be narrow (little shoulder) at certain points.

- | Miles | Directions |
|--------------|-----------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| 0.0 | Start of ride at El Dorado Hills Blvd and Town Center Blvd (at shopping center). Head South on El Dorado Hills Blvd (away from Hwy. 50) |
| 7.8 | Railroad Tracks at top of hill (cross with caution). |
| 8.1 | Intersection with Latrobe Road (just past top of hill). Turn Left on South Shingle Rd. |
| 10.2 | Turn Right on Brandon. |
| 11.3 | Railroad tracks (cross with caution). |
| 12.3 | Brandon Rd ends. Turn Left on French Creek Rd. |
| 16.8 | Veer towards Right at intersection. Road becomes Old French Town Rd. |
| 19.4 | Two directions follow quickly. Turn Right on Motherlode Dr. Immediate Left follows onto Greenstone Rd. |
| 19.9 | Railroad tracks – this one particularly bumpy (cross with caution). |
| 22.0 | Turn Left on Green Valley Rd. |
| 24.6 | Intersection with Lotus Rd. Go towards Left (still Green Valley Rd). |
| 25.5 | Turn sharp Right for Green Valley Rd (towards Rescue and Cameron Park). |
| 26.1 | Town of Rescue (limited groceries). |
| 28.8 | Intersection with Cameron Park Dr (groceries, supplies). Continue straight. |

- 33.6 Left on Silva Valley Rd
(No lights or stop sign here –
Silva Valley Road is on left side only about 200 yards before stoplight).
- 36.4 Turn Right at stop sign onto Serrano Parkway. Brief climb, then spectacular descent follows.
- 37.6 Serrano Parkway ends at stoplight. Turn Left onto El Dorado Hills Blvd.
- 38.6 Ride ends at Town Center Blvd and El Dorado Hills Blvd.
